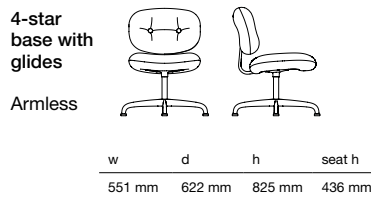
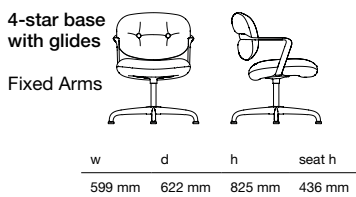
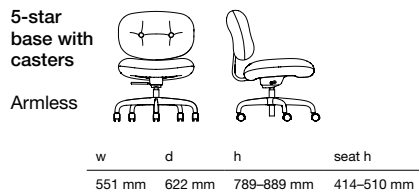
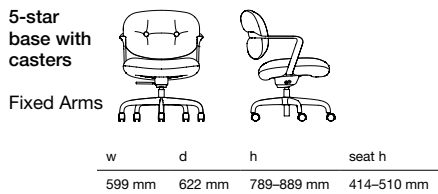


Key Features
